BLOOMING PRAIRIE PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Go to <https://www.blossoms.k12.mn.us/page/3927> and complete all the required fields, this will enroll the students in the meal program and will be considered an electronic signature so there is no need to come in. If you have questions, please contact the High School office at 507-583-4426.. The food will be available until students are allowed to return to school. The food will be available from 11am-12:30pm for pickup at the curb of Blooming Prairie High School.

BYRON PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Breakfast/lunch will be provided throughout the school closure. Parents must send an email daily to pat.ronnenberg@byron.k12.mn.us by 10am the day before food pickup or call **507-624-0309** to leave a message/talk with food service. For example contact on Wednesday for Thursday pick-up. All food pickup will be available at 9am at Byron Intermediate School located at 501 10th Ave NE, Byron, MN

HAYFIELD PUBLIC SCHOOLS

KASSON-MANTORVILLE SCHOOLS

- During a closure, the District will provide free meals for all students in need.
- Grab-and-go meals will be made available in the following pickup locations from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. daily (Monday-Friday) during a closure:
 - High School North Doors
 - Elementary School Main Entrance
 - Riverside Park in Mantorville (Near the dam parking lot)
 - St. John's Lutheran Church in Kasson
 - Windsor Court in Kasson (West of the new KwikTrip)
- Look for a school van or bus at each location.

- In addition to the lunch provided, each student will also receive breakfast for the following day
- Note: If you are unable to access one of the Grab-and-Go sites during that time frame, **please call your building secretary before 10 am, and we will deliver a meal to your home or email at meals@komet.k12.mn.us** We can't guarantee delivery without this advanced notice, so please call in every morning if delivery is desired. Please know that timelines for delivery will vary considerably, but we will attempt to get all delivery meals to your home before 1:30 pm

PINE ISLAND PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Beginning on Monday, March 23rd, limited meal service will be distributed at the 5-12 building in a “grab-n-go” format for those in need. Curbside pick-up will be offered from 6-8am on a daily basis. STEWARTVILLE PUBLIC SCHOOLS

We have finalized our plans for the delivery of meals for March 23 through March 27.

Grab-and-go meals will be available for pick-up at the following sites from 10:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. on Monday through Friday. The district will not be providing options for congregating dining at any site.

- At each site, we will only have enough meals for the families who have pre-registered for the program. To participate in the meal program, complete the form at this link: <https://forms.gle/3mE3e5UvkUcrJSLn7> by 10:00 a.m. on weekdays in order to receive meals on the following day. Once a family has signed up for meals, the form will not need to be completed again.
- At all distribution sites, we will be following the guidelines for social distancing. As families and children wait to pick up their meals, we will be asking everyone to remain at least 6 feet apart. Once meals have been picked up, families and children should return to their vehicles or homes.
